From the desk of Dereck...

Developing Your Own Faith

"And do not think you can say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham as our father.' I tell you that out of these stones God can raise up children for Abraham. The ax is already at the root of the trees, and every tree that does not produce good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire" (Matthew 3:9–10).

John the Baptist responded in this way to the Pharisees and Sadducees who came to where he was baptizing. John's statement bears a difficult truth—God's people have strayed. The Pharisees and Sadducees were misinterpreting the old covenant. Although it was a blessing to be part of Abraham's lineage, being part of Abraham's legacy was not what saved people. It was the fulfilment of the promise through Jesus that gave people freedom from sin (Galatians 3:27–29).

As a result, our Christian lineages vary widely. Some come from families that have followed Christ for generations, while others are the first to repent and be baptized in their home. To Christ, it makes no difference. Each of us is responsible for bearing fruit. Romans 11:20 makes the imagery even clearer. Branches were broken off for unbelief. Our faith must be our own.

Consider Timothy as an example of what an authentic faith looks like: "For I am mindful of the sincere faith with-in you, which first dwelt in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice, and I am sure that is in you as well" (2 Timothy 1:5). Timothy grew up with a godly mother and grandmother, but he didn't assume he'd automatically be connected to God because he was a part of their family tree. As Paul said, he developed a "sincere" faith.

A sincere faith is one in which we give our full allegiance to the name of Jesus rather than our family name. Let's make sure we are connected to Jesus who is the only vine that can empower us to produce spiritual fruit. "I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing" (John 15:4).

May we live in a space that never tries to have any kind of entitlement or privilege but live by the grace of God alone.
